The Department of Pathology, KLE JGMM Medical College, Hubballi (a constituent unit of KAHER, Belagavi), organized an E-Poster Competition for Phase II MBBS students (2024–2025 batch) on 21st February 2026, in observance of World Cancer Day.

World Cancer Day 2026 carried the global theme “**United by Unique,**” emphasizing the importance of individualized cancer care, patient-centered approaches, and collaborative efforts in the fight against cancer.

In alignment with this global message, the objective of the E-Poster Competition was to promote **cancer awareness** among students by encouraging evidence-based learning, early detection strategies, preventive measures, and a multidisciplinary understanding of oncological diseases. For further academic guidance, the selected teams were assigned respective faculty mentors.

The programme began with a welcome and introductory speech by Dr. Priyanka Murgod, Associate Professor, Department of Pathology, following which the event was smoothly conducted by Dr. Vidya Kuchanur, Assistant Professor, Department of Pathology.








